How it works

Teladoc's network of state-licensed primary care physicians can diagnose routine, non-emergency, medical problems, recommend treatment and prescribe short-term, non-DEA-controlled medications, when needed.

Teladoc is available in all 50 states.² Members can connect with network physicians for telephonic or face-to-face, online video consultations 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Claims for consultations are billed at a flat fee, and the costs can be shared with the member through a co-payment arrangement. UMR facilitates with Teladoc for eligibility and billing services, and claims are processed under the employer's medical plan administered by UMR.

Prescriptions are called into the patient's pharmacy of choice, and claims are processed under the employer's pharmacy benefits plan.

Measuring results

Teladoc helps customers determine their return on investment and provides monthly reporting packages. The reports show the current monthly and yearly utilization, with breakdowns by primary members vs. dependents, age, gender and state.

They also detail the interface used to deliver the consults – telephonic or video – and list the 10 most common diagnosis codes and prescribed medications.
