Your Rights

You have the right to:

Summary Annual Report

For Iowa Telecom Savings Plan

This is a summary of the annual report for Iowa Telecom Savings Plan, Employer Identification Number 42-1490040, Plan No. 001 for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided through a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$1,100,765. These expenses included \$22,778 in administrative expenses and \$1,077,987 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 659 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$30,160,252, as of December 31, 2009 compared to \$15,530,888 as of January 1, 2009. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$14,629,364. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$8,717,099, including employer contributions of \$2,035,534, employee contributions of \$1,971,933, other contributions of \$117,015, and earnings from investments of \$4,592,617.

This is a summary of the annual report of the Iowa Telecommunications Services Inc. Salaried Group Benefit Plan, EIN 42-1490040, Plan No. 510, for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

The company has committed itself to paying certain claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Wellmark Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Iowa, Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Delta Dental of Iowa, Vision Service Plan Insurance Company and Zurich American Insurance Company to pay certain health, life insurance, prescription drug, dental, vision, long-term disability and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2009 were \$4,067,393.

Because there are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2009, the premiums paid under these "experience-rated" contracts were \$3,797,070 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$3,740,443.
